Reference: Multi-agency investigation leads to arrest of suspected drug/alcohol trafficker

Dianne Drive – Lyon County

At 3 pm on December 18, 2019, Lyon County Sheriff's Office personnel responded with the Pennyrile Narcotics Task Force (PNTF), Eddyville Police Department, and Princeton Police Department to 438 Dianne Drive, Eddyville for the purpose of executing a search warrant on the premises as it related to illegal narcotics trafficking.

Upon arrival, subjects inside the residence and two subjects outside the residence were detained. The two subjects outside had pulled up to the residence for the purpose of purchasing alcoholic beverages.

Upon searching the property, a large quantity of pills was seized along with marijuana, drug paraphernalia, a moonshine still, and numerous cases of alcoholic beverages, to include multiple containers of moonshine. The homeowner, Dennis Traylor (71), was arrested by PNTF and charged with the following offenses:

- 1. Trafficking in Controlled Substance-1st Degree***
- 2. Trafficking in Marijuana***
- 3. Drug Paraphernalia-Possession***
- 4. Unlicensed Manufacturing/Sale/Store/Purchase/Transport of Alcoholic Beverages-1st Offense***

Traylor was lodged in the Crittenden County Jail. The remaining subjects on the property and in the vehicle were released with no charges at this time. A digital photograph of the offender is attached as a matter of reference.
