Reference: Three-Vehicle Injury Collision Investigation

(KUTTAWA)

On March 14, 2020 at 1045am, the Lyon County Sheriff's Office responded to a three-vehicle collision with injuries at the cross-over intersection of US 62, Lake Barkley Drive, and KY 93 North in Kuttawa.

A 2015 Honda Pilot operated by Allison L. Nelson (30) of Owensboro was at the intersection of KY 93 North and US 62, heading South and attempting to cross-over US 62 to Lake Barkley Drive. A 2014 Ford F-150 pickup truck operated by Tina Foglesong (19) of Oneida, IL and occupied by four (4) passengers, was East bound on US 62 at the same time. A 2014 Kia Sorento operated by Tara Stinnett (62) of Kuttawa was also East bound on US 62 at the same time.

This collision investigation revealed operator Nelson, due to inattention, failed to yield the right of way to the Foglesong vehicle, and collided with Foglesong's vehicle by way of an angle collision. This initial collision caused the Foglesong vehicle to rotate in an out-of-control spin, resulting in another collision between the Foglesong vehicle and the Stinnett vehicle. Both the Nelson and Foglesong vehicles were damaged to the extent it rendered them inoperable.

A passenger in the Foglesong vehicle complained of back pain; however, they declined to be transported to the hospital after being examined by Lyon County EMS personnel.

Senior Deputy Sam Adams of the Sheriff's Office was assisted at the scene by Lyon County EMS, Kuttawa Fire Department, and Eddyville Police Department.
