Reference: 2 Vehicle Injury Collision

(EDDYVILLE)

On July 4, 2020 at 11:00am, the Lyon County Sheriff's Office responded to a 2-vehicle injury collision on US 62 at the KY 818 North intersection, approximately 4 miles East of Eddyville.

The investigation revealed a 2008 GMC Acadia, driven by Robert T. Hunt (23) of Madisonville was driving West bound on US 62 when the driver failed to realize a 2019 Buick Encore, driven by Peggy Oliver (72) was making a left turn off of US 62 West bound onto KY 818 North. Hunt's vehicle collided with the rear of the Oliver vehicle causing the Oliver vehicle to roll over several times.

Ms. Oliver was the only person in her vehicle at the time of the collision. She was injured and later transported to the hospital by Lyon County EMS. Mr. Hunt received a slight hand injury in the collision. He was transported to a nearby hospital, by a friend, where he was treated and released. An 8-year old passenger in the Hunt vehicle was not injured in the collision.

Robert T. Hunt was later charged with Failure to Produce an Insurance Card by Deputy Sam Adams after he was released from the hospital.

The Lyon County Sheriff's Office was assisted by Lyon County EMS, Lyon County Rescue Squad, and the Eddyville Fire Department.
