Reference: Injury Collision

(EDDYVILLE)

On October 14, 2020 at or about 10:35am, the Lyon County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to a two-vehicle injury collision on US 641, approximately 2.5 miles North of Eddyville.

The investigation by Deputy Sam Adams revealed a 2015 Harley Davidson motorcycle operated by Billy R. Marvel (58) of Marion was South bound on US 641, just South of the KY 1943 intersection. A 2018 Harley Davidson motorcycle operated by Jon C. Shackelford (62) was also South bound on US 641, directly behind the Marvel motorcycle.

A pedestrian was walking South on US 641 and was on the Skinframe Creek Bridge at the time of the collision. Traffic in the South bound lanes came to a stop due to meeting an oncoming semi-tractor & trailer which was Northbound at the same time the pedestrian was on the bridge. As a result, the Marvel motorcycle had to come to an abrupt stop in traffic. This resulted in the Shackelford motorcycle rear-ending the Marvel motorcycle and causing both vehicles to overturn.

Shackelford was transported by Lyon County EMS to Baptist Health-Paducah for incapacitating injuries. No other injuries were reported. US 641 was shutdown for approximately 1.5 hours while the scene was cleaned up.

The Lyon County Sheriff's Office was assisted by Lyon County EMS and the KY Transportation Cabinet.
