



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

1. On Monday, February 14, 2022, at 2:30pm, Deputy Keith Suits charged Kimberly M. Boyles (49) of Ohio with being a Fugitive from Another State. Boyles faces charges in Green County, Ohio for violation of a Court Order. She will be held in the Ross-Cash Correctional Complex pending extradition back to Ohio.
2. On Monday, February 14, 2022, at 11:15pm, Deputy Seth P'Pool was dispatched to a reckless driving and suspicious vehicle complaint. He located the vehicle in question, a 2006 Mercury Mountaineer and he attempted to conduct a traffic stop just West of Kuttawa after observing it traveling East at 87MPH in a 55MPH zone. The operator failed to stop for Deputy P'Pool, and a pursuit ensued and turned off US 62 and onto KY 93 North.

A felony traffic stop was conducted and the driver, identified as William M. 'Mac' McQuigg, Jr. (39) was arrested on KY 93 North, without further incident. The driver was manifestly under the influence of an intoxicating substance. He was found to possess suspected Methamphetamine as well. McQuigg was charged with the following offenses and lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center:

- Speeding 26 MPH or more over the limit
- Failure to Wear Seat Belts
- Careless Driving
- Fleeing/Evading Police-1st Degree (motor vehicle)
- DUI-1st Offense
- Failure of Owner to Maintain Required Insurance-1st Offense
- Possession of Controlled Substance-1st Degree (Methamphetamine)

The Eddyville Police Department assisted Deputy P'Pool with this arrest and investigation.

3. On Tuesday, February 15, 2022, at 9:35am, the Livingston County Sheriff's Office located a female with a Lyon County Circuit Court warrant for her arrest regarding a Probation Violation. They brought her to Chief Deputy Sam Adams who identified her as Tawny M. Clinton (33) of Grand Rivers. She was served a Lyon Circuit Court Bench Warrant and was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
4. On Wednesday, February 16, 2022, around 7:30am, Sheriff Brent White conducted a traffic stop on a 2020 Nissan passenger car on US 62 for a traffic violation and registration violation. The driver was identified as Grace A. Archield (26) of Metairie, LA. She was found to be operating on a suspended/revoked operator's license from Louisiana for failure to appear in court. She was arrested and charged with Speeding (16 mph or more over the limit), Display/Possession of a Cancelled or Fictitious Operator's License and Operating on a Suspended or Revoked Operator's License. She was taken to Lyon District Court which was in session on this date.
5. On Tuesday, February 15, 2022, Sheriff Brent White received a theft complaint from a resident who lived North off Suwanee off KY 810 North. The investigation led to the identity of a juvenile offender. On Wednesday, February 16, 2022, around 2:45pm Sheriff White detained and charged a 13-year-old juvenile charging him with Fraudulent Use of a Credit Card and Theft by Unlawful Taking Under \$500.
6. On Wednesday, February 16, 2022, around 9:10pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon was dispatched to a single vehicle collision on US 62 West near Kuttawa. His investigation revealed a 2014 Toyota Camry driven by Scott Pakkala (46) of Grand Rivers was East on US 62 when a deer ran into his path. He was unable to avoid the collision and the vehicle was disabled resulting in it having to be towed from the scene.
7. On Wednesday, February 16, 2022, around 11pm, Deputy Seth P'Pool conducted a traffic stop on a 1989 Pontiac Firebird on US 62 West for a registration violation. The driver was identified as Skylar Groves (21) of Marion. He was found to be operating on a license which was suspended and found to have an active arrest warrant. Deputy P'Pool arrested Groves and charged him with Operating on a Suspended/Revoked License and the Bench Warrant for Failure to Appear in Crittenden District Court. Groves was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

8. On Thursday, February 17, 2022, around 8:55pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon and a Kentucky State Police Trooper was dispatched to a residence on Martins Chapel Road for a disturbance. Deputy Witherspoon determined that Tyler J. Hickson (19) of Kuttawa was intoxicated and had assaulted a female victim at the home resulting in minor injury to the victim. Hickson was arrested by Deputy Witherspoon and charged with Assault – 4th Degree. He was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

9. On Friday, February 18, 2022, at 1:30pm, Chief Deputy Sam Adams served an arrest warrant on Shannon Roskin (31) of Ashland, charging her with Failure to Appear on a Floyd District Court Bench Warrant. She will be lodged in the Ross-Cash Correctional Complex before being returned to Floyd County.

10. On Saturday, February 19, 2022, at 4:50pm, Deputy Keith Suits served a criminal complaint on Charles A. Schneider (74) of Eddyville, charging him with Theft of Property Lost or Mislaid. He was summoned to Lyon District Court. The case was investigated by Chief Jaime Green of the Eddyville Police Department.
