



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

1. On Monday, March 14, 2022, at 6:54pm, Deputy Keith Suits noticed a suspicious vehicle while on patrol in Eddyville. A check of the registration revealed the owner of the vehicle had a suspended driver's license. Deputy Suits contacted the vehicle and its operator on Funway Drive. Further investigation led to Billy W. Ross (37) of Wellington being charged with Operating on a Suspended/Revoked License, Possession of Marijuana, and Drug Paraphernalia-Possession.
2. On Wednesday, March 16, 2022, around 2pm, Sheriff Brent White charged Thomas D. Jacobs (50) of Lebanon on a Marion County District Court Bench Warrant for Failure to Appear. He is awaiting extradition back to Marion County. In addition, Jacobs was also charged on a Washington County District Court Bench Warrant for Non-payment of Court Costs, Fees, or Fines.
3. On Wednesday, March 16, 2022, around 4:45pm, Deputy Keith Suits and Chief Deputy Sam Adams responded to the 1000 block of Joe Peek Road for a theft and trespassing complaint. While there, they located Nick C. Hatfield (56) of Smithland. Hatfield was wanted by Kentucky State Police for Methamphetamine related offenses in Livingston County. He was arrested by Deputy Suits and charged with Possession of Controlled Substance-1st Degree, 2nd Offense, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. A theft case has been opened in response to the property owner reporting numerous items stolen from the property, including ATVs, hand tools, power tools, and miscellaneous other items. The investigation is continuing by Deputy Suits.
4. On Friday, March 18, 2022, around 8:10am, Chief Deputy Sam Adams charged Deonta Kidd (43) of Bowling Green on a Failure to Appear Bench Warrant from Logan District Court. Kidd awaits extradition back to Logan County.

5. On Saturday, March 19, 2022, around 7:40pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon was dispatched to a two-vehicle collision on US 62, just East of the KY 93 North intersection. His investigation revealed a 2013 GMC Yukon driven by Corrine F. Hresko (49) of Kuttawa failed to yield the right of way to a 2007 Honda Accord driven by Brandon Cooke (28) of Fredonia. Neither drivers, nor Cooke's passenger, an 18-month-old child, was injured. Hresko was found to be driving on a suspended operator's license. She was charged with Operating on a Suspended/Revoked License.
