



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On March 31, 2021 at around 2pm, Deputy Sam Adams was called upon to investigate a shoplifting incident at the Dollar General Store on Vista Drive in Kuttawa. The suspect left the store prior to the arrival of sheriff's deputies. Deputy Adams was able to positively identify the suspect in this case. On April 3, 2021, he charged Melissa Appleby (39) of Dawson Springs with Theft by Unlawful Taking Under \$500.
2. On April 2, 2021 at around 11:10pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon conducted a traffic stop on a 2007 Pontiac G6 passenger car on US 62 West. During his roadside contact with the driver, Deputy Witherspoon detected the odor of marijuana coming from the car. Further investigation revealed the driver was in possession of marijuana, smoking pipes, and a grinder. The driver was identified as Larry T. Noel (21) of Cadiz. He was charged with Speeding 20 MPH over the Limit, Operating Vehicle with Expired License, Possession of Marijuana, and Drug Paraphernalia-Possession.
3. On April 4, 2021 at around 1:48am, Deputy Keith Suits conducted a traffic stop on a 2017 Chevrolet Silverado on US 62 East near Industrial Park Road. During his roadside contact with the driver, it was determined the male operator was under the influence. Standard Field Sobriety Tests were given and the driver, identified as Jacob R. Klueppel (19) of Eddyville was subsequently arrested and charged with Speeding 13 MPH over the Limit, and DUI-1st Offense.
