



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

1. On Thursday evening, April 14, 2022, Deputy Keith Suits served Lacey K. Kelley (43) and Joseph T. Kelley (45) both of Kuttawa with criminal complaints for violating the Lyon County Nuisance Ordinance. Both subjects were summoned to Lyon District Court in May regarding this offense.
2. On Thursday, April 14, 2022, just after 11pm, Deputy Keith Suits was dispatched to a single-vehicle collision on I-24 near the US 62 intersection in Kuttawa. His investigation revealed a 2012 Toyota being driven by Tabitha L. Cox (38) of Eddyville was East bound on the on-ramp when she collided with a deer. Neither the driver, nor her passenger, April Cox (57), of Eddyville were injured.
3. On Friday, April 15, 2022, around midnight, Deputy Keith Suits was dispatched to the 100 block of KY 810 South for a suspicious person complaint. Upon arrival, he was told by the caller that an unknown female had been on their porch for a considerable amount of time, and the caller was starting to be concerned as the female seemed confused.

Deputy Suits located the female and determined she was extremely under the influence of a controlled substance. She told the deputy she was playing the "Enders Game". The female led the deputy to the location where she had hidden her Methamphetamine while playing the game. The location was under the beam of a guardrail on the right-of-way of KY 810 South. The female was arrested by Deputy Suits. She was identified as Melissa E. Kornegay (33) of Kuttawa. She was charged with Public Intoxication-Controlled Substance and Possession of Controlled Substance-1st Degree, 1st Offense (Methamphetamine). Kornegay was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

4. On Friday, April 15, 2022, at 9:40pm, Deputy Keith Suits made a traffic stop on a gray, 2011 Toyota Tundra on US 62 West. The driver was identified as Terry B. Peede (40) of Eddyville. Following a roadside investigation, he was arrested and charged with DUI-1st Offense and Failure to Wear Seat Belts. Peede was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
