



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On May 1, 2021 around 6:15am, Deputy Sam Adams responded to the Huck's Travel Center in Kuttawa for an abduction complaint. Upon his arrival, he learned a male subject had jumped out of a vehicle at the KSP Eastbound Scales on I-24 before beating on the door of a parked semi-tractor/trailer requesting help. He then got into the same vehicle he was originally a passenger in and left before being located at the Huck's Travel Center off Exit 40 in Kuttawa. Prior to Deputy Adams' arrival the same subject called 911 and reported he had been kidnapped.

Deputy Adams identified the subject as James L. Brown (32) of Marion, Arkansas. He was determined to be manifestly under the influence of Methamphetamine and Amphetamines. He was placed under arrest and charged with Public Intoxication before being lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

2. On May 1, 2021 around 11:20pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon and Deputy Seth P'Pool responded to Buzzard Rock Road in Kuttawa for an assault complaint. Upon arrival, they found a female victim who had been assaulted and discovered the offender had fled the area prior to their arrival. Deputies alerted area law enforcement to be on the lookout for the offender's vehicle.

The victim had obvious injuries and reported the offender held her against her will on a boat and would not allow her to leave. In addition, he allegedly threatened to kill her and her grandchildren. The investigation also revealed the offender took the victim's cellular phone in order to prevent her from summoning help.

The offender was identified as Patrick C. Sheridan (50) of Princeton. He was located and arrested by Caldwell County Sheriff's Deputies for DUI-1st Offense in Princeton. In addition, Deputy Witherspoon charged Sheridan with Assault-4th Degree, Unlawful Imprisonment-1st Degree, Terroristic Threatening-3rd Degree, and Interfering with Communications.
