



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

1. On Tuesday, May 10, 2022, around 10:20am, Chief Deputy Sam Adams responded to several complaints of a vehicle driving recklessly through the city of Eddyville. Deputy Adams located the vehicle on US 62 East. The vehicle was stopped on the I-69 on-ramp from US 62. Following a roadside investigation, Kiet V. Nguyen (63) of Harvey, Louisiana was arrested and charged with Failure to Wear Seat Belts and DUI (alcohol)-1st Offense. Nguyen was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
2. On Wednesday, May 11, 2022, around 11:45am, Chief Deputy Adams took an identity theft report from a Kuttawa resident. The investigation revealed the victim received an alert message on his phone with whom he believed was Amazon advising him of an order he did not make. When he inquired about the order, he was asked to provide all his identifying information so they could investigate the order. Unfortunately, this was a scam and a ruse to obtain the victim's identity, which was successful by the unidentified scammers.
3. On Thursday, May 12, 2022, around 4:55am, Chief Deputy Adams was dispatched to a single vehicle collision on KY 3305 between Elkhorn Tavern Road and Jacks Way. The investigation revealed a 2011 Freightliner truck was South on KY 3305 when a deer entered the roadway in its path. The driver, identified as Donanrdus Kimbrough (35) of Lagrange, Georgia attempted to avoid the animal, but lost control after overcorrecting and overturned before impacting an earth embankment. No injuries were reported, although there was significant damage to the truck.
4. On Friday, May 13, 2022, around 4:10pm, Deputy Keith Suits charged James B. Gallagher (55) of Kuttawa with a Contempt of Court/Probation Violation bench warrant from McCracken Circuit Court. Gallagher is lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

5. On Saturday, May 14, 2022, at 1am, Deputy Keith Suits arrested Adam W. Hays (43) of Marion on a Lyon Circuit Court indictment warrant charging him with the following offenses:
 - a. Possession of Controlled Substance-1st Degree (Methamphetamine)
 - b. Drug Paraphernalia-Possession
 - c. Failure of Owner to Maintain Required Insurance-2nd Offense
 - d. No Registration Plates
 - e. No Registration Receipt
 - f. Operating on a Suspended/Revoked Operator's License
 - g. Failure to Register Transfer of a Motor Vehicle

Hays was lodged in the Hopkins County Detention Center.

6. On Saturday, May 14, 2022, at 6:25pm, Deputy Keith Suits charged Clinton G. Taylor (30) of Kuttawa on a criminal summons from Caldwell District Court charging him with Failure to Notify Owner of an Unattended Vehicle of Damage (Leaving the Scene of an Accident). The case was investigated by the Princeton Police Department. Taylor was summoned to court by Deputy Suits.

On Saturday, May 14 and Sunday May 15, 2022, Sheriff White and deputies from the Lyon County Sheriff's Office assisted the Lyon County High School with Grand March, Prom, and Project Prom activities throughout the evening and until the next morning. There were no incidents throughout the night and the Sheriff's Office wishes to thank the students, school staff, parents, donors, sponsors, and volunteers for making this a successful series of events.
