



## **LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE**

1. On Saturday, May 28, 2022, around 8pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon was dispatched to a two-vehicle non-injury collision in Kuttawa on US 62. His investigation revealed a 2007 Honda CR-V driven by Jaclynn J. Waugh (23) of Bedford was making a left turn on a yellow directional arrow at the stoplight from US 62 West into the Huck's Travel Center, when the driver failed to yield the right of way and pulled into the path of a 2014 Chevrolet Silverado pickup driven by Christie L. Suyapno (18) of Eddyville. The Waugh vehicle was disabled, and no injuries were reported in this collision.
2. On Saturday, June 4, 2022, around 11:23am, Chief Deputy Sam Adams was dispatched to a single-vehicle injury collision on KY 274, approximately 15 miles South of Eddyville. The investigation revealed a 2003 Kawasaki motorcycle driven by Gary S. Hix (71) of Cadiz was pulling out of Dryden Creek Road onto KY 274 when he encountered loose gravel and lost control of the motorcycle before exiting the roadway and going down an earth embankment. Hix was transported to Caldwell County Medical Center by Lyon County EMS for non-life-threatening injuries. Hix was charged by Chief Deputy Adams with Improper Registration Plate and Failure to Register the Transfer of a Motor Vehicle.
