



## **LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT**

- 1.** On Tuesday, June 29, 2021, at 9:30pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon investigated a two-vehicle non-injury collision, in Kuttawa, at the intersection of Days Inn Drive and US 62 West. A 2019 Freightliner driven by Sidney Remarais (48) of S. Hampstead, NY was turning off US 62 onto Days Inn Drive when he collided with a 2019 GMC Acadia driven by Stanley Repasky (72) of Willow, OK.
- 2.** On Wednesday, June 30, 2021, at 9:13am, Deputy Sam Adams investigated a two-vehicle non-injury collision, in Kuttawa, at the Huck's Travel Center. A 2001 Ford Explorer driven by Christine Hill (56) of Kuttawa collided with a parked 2020 GMC Sierra owned by Bennett Motors of Mayfield in the parking lot of the truck stop.
- 3.** On Wednesday, June 30, 2021, at 9:40am, Sheriff Brent White responded to US 641 for a possible burglary in progress call. A property owner came home to a suspicious vehicle in his driveway in which he did not recognize. Further investigation revealed a teenager had come to the home in the car and accidentally locked their keys in the vehicle with it running, before leaving on foot from the property. The vehicle was blocking a garage; and when the owner could not be located, it was entered and removed by a wrecker service. During this process, Marijuana was observed in the vehicle, in plainview. As a result of the investigation, Tonya M. Yaw (46) of Hampton was charged with Possession of Marijuana and Drug Paraphernalia Possession. She was cited to Lyon District Court.
- 4.** On Wednesday, June 30, 2021, at 5:52pm, Deputy Seth P'Pool and Sheriff White responded to a two-vehicle, commercial vehicle injury collision on US 641, approximately 1.2 miles North of Eddyville. Upon arrival of first responder personnel from multiple local agencies, it was determined the driver of one of the commercial vehicles was deceased at the scene. Kentucky State Police was requested by Sheriff White to conduct a collision reconstruction investigation of this incident. The collision remains under


investigation by Kentucky State Police, Post 1-Mayfield. US 641 North was closed until 1:20am on July 1, 2021, due to this fatality collision and investigation.

5. On Thursday, July 1, 2021, at 8am, Sheriff White arrested and charged John Paul Hill (45) of Hopkinsville on a Bench Warrant from Todd Circuit Court charging him with Failure to Appear.

On Thursday, July 1, 2021, at 2:30pm, Deputy Adams, Sheriff White, Deputy P'Pool, and EPD Chief Jaime Green responded to a disturbance complaint in the 1600 block of Elkhorn Tavern Road, East of Eddyville. Upon arrival, Sheriff White located a female who claimed to be a victim in a domestic dispute. During the investigation, they located a male subject, alleged to have been the perpetrator in the domestic dispute. The male was identified as Robert G. McGregor, Jr. (47) of Princeton; he was found hiding in a nearby mobile home. He was arrested by Deputy P'Pool and charged on a Bench Warrant from Caldwell District Court for failing to report to the Caldwell County Jail to serve a 10-day jail sentence for an unrelated domestic violence incident. He was subsequently lodged in the Caldwell County Jail.

7. On Thursday, July 1, 2021, at 11:06pm, Deputy P'Pool charged Justin D. Connor (33) on a Lyon County Bench Warrant for Failure to Pay or Appear on a previous case, investigated by the Sheriff's Office, in which he was found guilty of Criminal Trespass and Theft offenses. He was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
