



## **LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE**

- 1.** On Tuesday, June 28, 2022, around 11:30am, Chief Deputy Sam Adams served Stephanie Cramer (45) of Monticello with a Wayne County Circuit Court indictment warrant charging her with Trafficking in a Controlled Substance-1<sup>st</sup> Degree (greater than 2 grams of Methamphetamine), Possession of Controlled Substance-3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, Possession of Marijuana, and Drug Paraphernalia-Possession. Cramer is lodged in the Ross-Cash Correctional Complex pending extradition back to Wayne County.
- 2.** On Saturday, July 2, 2022, just before 8pm, Deputy Keith Suits was dispatched to a DUI complaint in Kuttawa which originally started on Lake Barkley Drive and ended near Days Inn Drive. Deputy Suits located and subsequently arrested Charles W. Hill (69) of Eddyville and charged him with DUI-2<sup>nd</sup> Offense. Hill was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
- 3.** On Sunday, July 3, 2022, around 10:40pm, Deputy Keith Suits located Timothy W. May (44) of Kuttawa on West Main Street in Eddyville. May was the subject of a Lyon District Court bench warrant for Contempt of Court. He was arrested and subsequently lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
- 4.** On Monday, July 4, 2022, around 2pm, Deputy Seth P'Pool was assisting Kentucky State Police with a Traffic Safety Checkpoint on US 62 in Suwanee. A roadside investigation resulted in the arrest of Brian C. Goodson (38) of Kuttawa. He was charged with DUI-2<sup>nd</sup> Offense, Possession of Controlled Substance-1<sup>st</sup> Degree (Methamphetamine), Possession of Marijuana, and Drug Paraphernalia-Possession. Goodson was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

5. On Tuesday, July 5, 2022, around 1:20pm, Chief Deputy Sam Adams served two arrest warrants on Rhonda M. Johnson (66) of Paducah. Johnson was charged with Theft by Unlawful Taking (\$1,000 to less than \$10,000). Johnson voluntarily turned herself in to law enforcement and she was one of three suspects charged regarding a felony theft in the Suwanee community. The case was investigated by Sheriff Brent White. Johnson was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
6. On Wednesday, July 6, 2022, around 9am, Chief Deputy Sam Adams arrested Nicholas J. Doss (44) of Eddyville and served him with a Contempt of Court warrant from Ballard Circuit Court. He was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
7. On Thursday, July 7, 2022, around 9am, Deputy Lori Francis served a Trigg County District Court criminal summons on Andrea M. Breedlove (33) of Princeton, charging her with Theft by Unlawful Taking (\$1,000 to less than \$10,000). The incident was investigated by Trigg County law enforcement. Breedlove was summoned to court on the charge.
8. On Thursday, July 7, 2022, around 11:15am, Chief Deputy Sam Adams arrested Ashley Pratt (41) of Eddyville and served her with a Lyon Circuit Court indictment warrant charging her with Trafficking in a Controlled Substance-1<sup>st</sup> Degree (greater than 2 grams of Methamphetamine), Drug Paraphernalia-Possession, Possession of Controlled Substance-1<sup>st</sup> Degree (Opiates), and Possession of Controlled Substance-2<sup>nd</sup> Degree. The case was investigated by Deputy Joe Witherspoon. Pratt was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
9. On Thursday, July 7, 2022, just after 1pm, Chief Deputy Sam Adams arrested Kelly M. Oakley (44) of Princeton and served her with two, failure to appear, bench warrants involving two separate felony cases in Warren Circuit Court. Oakley was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
10. On Thursday, July 7, 2022, around 10:45pm, Deputy Keith Suits responded to a complaint of a suspicious person in Kuttawa on Days Inn Drive. He located the female off US 62 near Dooms Chapel Road. After further investigation, he arrested Rachel A. Mills (44) of Louisa and charged her with Public Intoxication, Possession of Marijuana, and Drug Paraphernalia-Possession. Mills was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

**11.** On Saturday, July 9, 2022, just after 10am, Deputy Joe Witherspoon and Deputy Seth P'Pool conducted a drug investigation on Green Road. Following a search at a residence, 80 marijuana plants and other items of evidence were seized. Deputy P'Pool arrested Carl A. Miner (59) and charged him with Cultivating Marijuana (5 or more plants) and Trafficking Marijuana (8oz.–5lbs.). Miner was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

**12.** On Saturday, July 9, 2022, around 8:50pm, Deputy Seth P'Pool was dispatched along with other law enforcement units to a disturbance at the Fivestar convenience store in Eddyville. The driver of a 2013 Nissan who was involved in the disturbance was identified as Karen L. Winberry (42) of Cedar Grove, TN. She was subsequently arrested and charged with DUI-1<sup>st</sup> Offense, Possession of Controlled Substance-3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, Possession of Marijuana, Drug Paraphernalia-Possession, and Prescription Not in Proper Container. Winberry was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

The second party involved in the disturbance was identified as Kayla N. Walsh (31), also of Cedar Grove, TN. She was also arrested and charged with Possession of Controlled Substance-3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, Possession of Marijuana, Drug Paraphernalia-Possession, and Prescription Not in Proper Container. Walsh was also lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
