



## LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On Wednesday, July 14, 2021, Deputy Sam Adams arrested Terry D. Cantrell (25) of Hopkinsville and charged him on a Failure to Appear warrant out of Todd District Court.
2. On Thursday, July 15, 2021, Deputy Adams arrested Trevion R. Clary (30) of Paducah and charged him on warrants for Burglary – 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, Theft By Unlawful Taking-Auto, and Criminal Mischief in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree. Clary was the subject of a manhunt on July 8<sup>th</sup> when he fled from Kentucky State Police. These charges were the result of the Sheriff's Office investigation into the break in at the rescue squad building and the subsequent theft of a rescue vehicle Clary used to flee to Caldwell County before his capture. He remains lodged in the Christian County Detention Center.
3. On Friday, July 16, 2021, Deputies Sam Adams, Randy Clark, and Sheriff Brent White, along with Lyon County EMS were dispatched to a home on KY 1943 for an assault victim. The victim was transported to Caldwell County Medical Center after wandering to a home from a wooded area around 6:55am. The victim was severely injured but was treated and later released from the hospital.

The Lyon County Sheriff's Office is continuing to investigate the incident. More information will be released as it becomes available. There is no threat to the public at this time. Suspects have been identified but are believed to be out of the area at this time. 4. On Friday, July 16, 2021, Deputy Seth P'Pool arrested William D. Zguro, Jr. (52) of Greenville and charged him on a Muhlenberg District Court warrant for Failure to Pay fines and costs.

5. On Friday, July 16, 2021, Deputy P'Pool arrested Christopher S. Adkins (32) of Middlesboro and charged him on a Bell Circuit Court warrant for Failure to Pay fines and costs.
  
6. On Friday, July 16, 2021, around 5pm, Deputies Adams, P'Pool, and Sheriff White responded to a disturbance complaint on Locust Street in Kuttawa. Following an investigation, Deputy P'Pool charged Mischelle L. Murphy (49) of Princeton with Possession of Marijuana and Drug Paraphernalia-Possession. Deputy P'Pool also charged Kristy M. Cotton (44) of Kuttawa with Assault-4<sup>th</sup> Degree (minor injury) for assaulting Murphy.
