



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On Friday, July 30, 2021, at 4pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon arrested Hannah R. Jobe (35) of Owensboro, after she voluntarily surrendered herself to the Lyon County Sheriff's Office following an investigation into a weekend assault incident in the Davenport Bay area of LBL on Lake Barkley.

Jobe was charged with the following offenses on the strength of warrants:

- Assault – 2nd Degree (2 counts)
- Strangulation – 1st Degree
- Terroristic Threatening-3rd Degree (3 counts)
- Criminal Mischief-2nd Degree
- Assault – 4th Degree

Jobe was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center. The investigation is continuing by Deputy Witherspoon. The Lyon County Sheriff's Office was assisted by officers of the Kentucky Dept. of Fish & Wildlife Resources.

On Saturday, July 24, 2021, Deputies with the Lyon County Sheriff's Office and Officers with the KY Dept. of Fish & Wildlife Resources were dispatched to an assault complaint in the Davenport Bay area of LBL. The investigation is still on-going, but at this time, it is believed an identified female assaulted three people while aboard a Cruiser on Lake Barkley. One of the victims required medical attention at an area hospital for a significant injury from this incident. The investigation is on-going, and charges are expected against the culpable party. Once all witness statements have been obtained, more information will be released to the public.
