



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On Saturday, July 31, 2021, around 7:15pm, Lyon County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to Days Inn Drive in Kuttawa in reference to an intoxicated male who was attempting to get into a vehicle and leave the parking lot of a local business.

Deputy Keith Suits arrived on scene first and located the intoxicated male at his car. He was manifestly under the influence of alcoholic beverages and admitted to being 'drunk'. After the intoxicated male began being disorderly with the deputy, he was told he was under arrest. Upon the deputy attempting to handcuff him, the intoxicated male began to physically and verbally resist efforts by the deputy to take him into custody. Deputy Seth P'Pool and Officer Shannon Oliver arrived and assisted Deputy Suits in gaining control of the intoxicated man. He was arrested without further incident.

The male offender was identified as Eugene Ison (63) of Elkton and he was charged with Alcohol Intoxication in a Public Place, Resisting Arrest, and Disorderly Conduct-2nd Degree. Ison was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

2. On Sunday, August 1, 2021, around 3pm, Eddyville Fire Department, Lyon County EMS, and Sheriff Brent White responded to the 400 block of Gray Farm Road for a single vehicle injury collision. The investigation revealed a 2009 Toyota Camry driven by Ervin J. Nichay, III (42) of Eddyville was Eastbound on Gray Farm Road when he failed to negotiate a curve, before leaving the roadway and impacting a tree. Nichay was the only occupant of the vehicle. He was seat belted and his air bags deployed saving him from more serious injury; however, the significance of the collision resulted in injury to his left foot and head. Nichay declined to be transported from the scene, by EMS, to the hospital; but, he was later taken to the hospital by private vehicle.
