



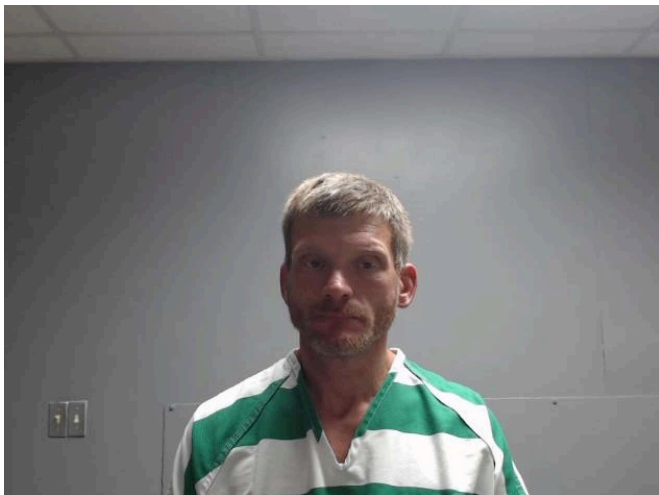
LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On Wednesday, August 11, 2021, at 9:30pm, Deputy Keith Suits arrested Gregory R. Cornish (40) of Fredonia following a traffic stop on KY 93 South of Eddyville. Cornish was charged with a Caldwell District Court bench warrant for Failure to Pay Child Support. He was lodged in the Caldwell County Jail.
2. On Thursday, August 12, 2021, at 4:50pm, Deputy Suits arrested Timothy W. May (43) of Eddyville on West Dale Avenue. May was charged with a Caldwell District Court bench warrant for Failure to Appear involving a Theft by Deception case. He was lodged in the Caldwell County Jail.
3. On Thursday, August 12, 2021, at 11:50pm, Deputy Suits was on patrol on US 62 East when he observed an equipment violation on a 2011 Mitsubishi Outlander. Upon stopping the vehicle, the driver was identified as Madison P. Cook (25) of Elizabethtown. Cook was found to have been operating on a suspended operator's license and had failed to appear in both Livingston and Lyon County District Courts on at least four (4) occasions in the recent past. Cook was arrested and charged with the following offenses:
 - a. Operating on a Suspended or Revoked Operator's License
 - b. No Tail Lamps
 - c. No InsuranceCook was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
4. On Friday, August 13, 2021, at 9:10am, Deputy Sam Adams served Jacob Armstrong (37) of Kuttawa with a criminal complaint/summons for Violation of a KY EPO/DVO which was investigated by the Sheriff's Office. Armstrong is alleged to have violated a protective order whereby he had a third party remove a boat from a protected party's residence after he had been served with a court order which prohibited him from having such contact and which prohibited from damaging or disposing of property between the parties. The boat had been

reported stolen by the owner on July 28, 2021, in Lyon County and was recovered from Jacob Armstrong's possession in Newburgh, Indiana on July 30, 2021.
