



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On Tuesday, August 17, 2021, around 4pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon responded to a two-vehicle collision on KY 293. The investigation revealed a 2010 Ford Expedition driven by John Whitfield (73) of Eddyville was North bound on KY 293 and operating immediately behind a 2015 Ford F150, pulling a utility trailer, driven by David French (57) of Eddyville, prior to the collision.

The French vehicle was preparing to turn left into the Dollar General store parking lot, when the operator swung wide to the right in order to make the turn with the trailer in tow. The Whitfield vehicle then attempted to pass to the left of the French vehicle, causing a collision when the French vehicle attempted to make the left-hand turn. There was property damage to both vehicles, but no injuries were reported.

2. On Tuesday, August 17, 2021, around 7pm, Deputy Witherspoon responded to a two-vehicle collision at Barkley Dam. The investigation revealed 2005 Chevrolet Impala driven by Dalton Hicks (17) of Princeton was backing up in the parking lot when he collided with a boat in tow by way of a trailer attached to a 2011 GMC Sierra owned by Huston Martin (26) of Madisonville. The collision caused extensive damage to the boat's outboard motor and minor damage to the boat. There were no injuries reported.
3. On Wednesday, August 18, 2021, around 6pm, Deputy Keith Suits conducted a traffic stop on a 2002 Ford F-150 pickup on Hopewell Road, after observing the vehicle run off the roadway numerous times before pulling into the driveway of a residence. He identified the operator as Don McGill (60) of Kuttawa. Following standard field sobriety tests, McGill was arrested and charged with DUI-1st Offense (alcohol), Failure to Wear Seat Belts, and Failure to Notify DOT of Address Change. McGill was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
