



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On Sunday, August 22, 2021, around 1:44pm, Deputy Keith Suits responded to a single vehicle, rollover collision on KY 810 South. His investigation revealed a 2007 Dodge Nitro, driven by Deandra J. Warner (20) of Kuttawa was North on KY 810 when an insect stung her on the arm and caused her to panic. She lost control of the vehicle which left the roadway and overturned. She was transported to the Caldwell County Medical Center for treatment of minor injuries. While Deputy Suits was inspecting Ms. Warner's vehicle's damage, he observed a hornet in the passenger compartment of the vehicle, which is believed to have been the insect which stung the driver. Deputy Suits was assisted by the Kuttawa Fire Department and Lyon County EMS.
2. On Wednesday, August 25, 2021, around 10am, Deputy Sam Adams located Kelly Campbell (43) of Grand Rivers, while she was in Eddyville. Campbell was arrested on a Livingston Circuit Court Bench Warrant for Bond Violations on a Felony case. She was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
3. On Wednesday, August 25, 2021, around 3:50pm, Deputy Sam Adams and Sheriff Brent White responded to a traffic hazard complaint on US 641 North where a tree limb had fallen and encroached the roadway. While officers were directing traffic around the hazard, a 2013 Jeep, operated by Bryan C. Wilson (37) of Grand Rivers was stopped. Wilson was found to have two children not restrained by way of booster seats. A check of his driver's license revealed Wilson was the respondent in a domestic violence protective court order, from Utah, which prohibited him from having contact with the children and their mother. Deputy Adams arrested Wilson and charged him with the offenses listed below. Wilson was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
 - a. Booster Seat Violations (2 counts)
 - b. No Insurance
 - c. Violation of a Foreign EPO/DVO

4. On Wednesday, August 25, 2021, around 4:17pm, Deputy Randy Clark was dispatched to a reckless driver complaint on US 641 North near the Caldwell County line. Deputy Clark located the vehicle, a 2019 International Penske rental box truck, pulling a car hauler trailer. Deputy Clark observed the vehicle's operator run off the roadway more than once. The deputy attempted to perform a traffic stop; however, the vehicle refused to stop for his emergency lights and siren.

The vehicle continued on US 641 and at one point ran another vehicle off the opposite shoulder of the highway. The vehicle crossed the intersection with US 62 before continuing onto KY 3305. At one point, the vehicle stopped after running in a ditch area, but then continued traveling on KY 3305.

Sheriff Brent White was able to block the roadway on KY 3305 and stop the truck's continued travel. The driver and a passenger were detained. The passenger was the employer for the driver, and he admitted he directed the driver not to stop for law enforcement.

The driver, identified as Trenton J. Doss (36), of Moscow Mills, Missouri, was charged with Reckless Driving and Failure to Stop or Give Right of Way to Emergency Vehicle. The passenger was identified as Lucian Predescu (62) of Tampa, Florida (formerly of Lake St. Louis, MO). He was charged with Permitting Unlawful Operation of a Motor Vehicle. Deputy Clark was assisted by Deputies Sam Adams, Seth P'Pool, and Sheriff White.
