



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On Friday, August 27, 2021, around 2:05 pm, Deputy Sam Adams and Sheriff Brent White responded to a disturbance call in Kuttawa on Major's Loop. Upon arrival, officers found a female and two males at the scene. The investigation revealed a male and female got into a verbal argument which turned physical whereby the male subject allegedly threw the female on the ground before getting on top of her and grabbing her neck. A male bystander witnessed the incident and stopped his vehicle to render aid to the female until law enforcement could arrive. The male offender was identified as Jeremiah M. Hill (36) of West Paducah, formerly of Eddyville. He was arrested by Sheriff White and charged with Assault-4th Degree (minor injury). He was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
2. On Saturday, August 28, 2021, around 3:50pm, Deputy Keith Suits located Austin L. Curington (21) off Rusty Ridge Road and arrested him pursuant to a Marshall District Court Bench Warrant for Failure to Appear on a traffic case. He was lodged in the Marshall County Detention Center.
3. On Saturday, August 28, 2021, around 5:30pm, Deputy Keith Suits and a Kentucky State Police Trooper were dispatched to a Kuttawa business for an intoxicated subject. Upon their arrival, they located the male subject who was manifestly intoxicated. He had ordered from the restaurant, but after receiving his items, declined to pay. After another patron agreed to pay for the subject's food and help sober him up, officers agreed to allow for this disposition and departed the scene. As soon as the officers left, the intoxicated male departed the business and attempted to leave by way of a boat. Officers were again called to the scene and located the subject attempting to leave in a boat. He was arrested by Deputy Suits and charged with Alcohol Intoxication in a Public Place -1st or 2nd Offense and lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

4. On Saturday, August 28, 2021, at 10:40pm, Deputy Keith Suits was dispatched to a traffic hazard complaint on US 641 for a man walking in the roadway. Upon his arrival, 2 miles North of Eddyville, he located and arrested Bobby D. Vailes (45) of Eddyville who was walking in the roadway. Vailes was wanted on two arrest warrants from Henderson County for Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle and Terroristic Threatening-3rd Degree, and another Bench Warrant from Caldwell County for Failure to Pay Child Support. He was lodged in the Caldwell County Jail.

5. On Sunday, August 29, 2021, at 07:10am, Deputy Keith Suits was dispatched to a single-vehicle, rollover collision approximately 4 miles North of Kuttawa on KY 295 North. The investigation revealed Carl R. Belt, Jr. (48) of Princeton was North bound on KY 295 driving a 2004 GMC Canyon pickup truck when he lost control and left the roadway before overturning multiple times and ending up in a residential yard. Deputy Suits charged Belt with Failure to Maintain Required Insurance-2nd Offense. There were no injuries reported in the collision. Deputy Suits was assisted by the Eddyville Fire Department, Kuttawa Fire Department, and Lyon County EMS.
