



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

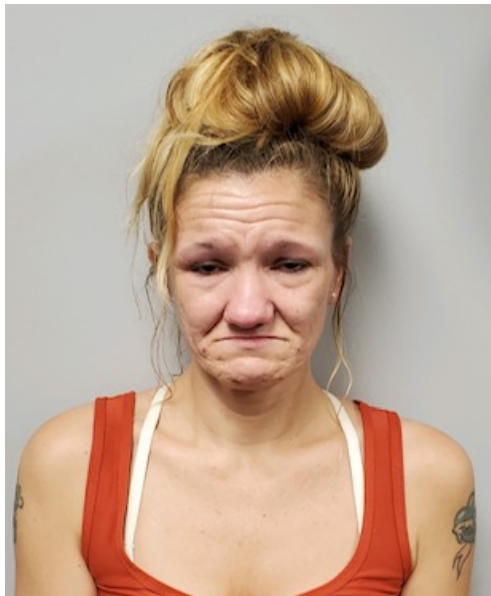
1. On Saturday, September 11, 2021, around 9am, a good Samaritan contacted Deputy Sam Adams and brought in a lady's ring which was found on City of Eddyville Park property. The owner has not been identified as of this date. If the owner of the ring can provide a confirming description and/or a photograph of it, deputies would like to get it back to its rightful owner.
2. On Monday, September 13, 2021, around 2pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon arrested Jordan S. Baize (37) of Kuttawa and charged him on a Complaint Warrant with Theft by Deception Over \$1,000. Baize is alleged to have written a check to a Kuttawa business for over \$3,600.00 knowing it would not be honored. He was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

3. On Wednesday, September 15, 2021, around 8:45am, Deputy Randy Clark served the same offender, Jordan S. Baize (37) of Kuttawa, in District Court, and charged him with a Muhlenberg County District Court Criminal Summons for Theft by Deception Under \$500. Baize is alleged to have issued another worthless check in excess of \$78.00 in this case.

4. On Saturday, September 18, 2021, around 4:19pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon was dispatched to a two-vehicle, collision on KY 810 North, near the intersection of US 62 West in Suwanee. The investigation revealed a 2001 Ford Escape driven by James A. Corley (30) of Kuttawa and occupied by two juvenile passengers, had just turned off US 62 onto KY 810 when Corley became distracted and veered into the opposing lane before colliding head-on with a 2016 Nissan Altima, driven by Laura Fralix (29) of Kuttawa. The Corley vehicle was rendered inoperable due to this collision. No injuries were reported.
5. On Sunday, September 19, 2021, around 2pm, Deputy Seth P'Pool responded to a two-vehicle collision on Travis Road, North of Kuttawa. The investigation revealed a 2007 Harley Davidson motorcycle driven by David C. Jamison (52) of Kuttawa was East bound when the failed to maintain his half of the roadway, in a curve, before colliding with a 2002 GMC Sierra driven by William R. Taylor (24) of Grand Rivers. Neither of the drivers were injured in the collision.
6. On Sunday, September 19, 2021, around 5pm, Deputy Seth P'Pool and Deputy Joe Witherspoon made a traffic stop on US 641 North of Eddyville. Further investigation revealed the passenger in the car was a wanted fugitive. She was identified as Sabrina G. Jones (aka: Samantha G. Adams / Sabrina Adams), (31) of Marion. Jones was served seven (7) arrest warrants by officers. One of the warrants was a Parole Violation Warrant and another was a Complaint Warrant charging her with the Attempted Murder of a Marion (KY) Police Officer following an incident on or about September 1, 2021, in Crittenden County. Jones was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center with no bond at this time.
