



## **LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE**

1. On Monday, September 19, 2022, around 3:50pm, Deputy Seth P'Pool arrested Lashawna Steward (43) of Kuttawa on Gum Street. Steward was served with a bench warrant from Lyon District Court where she failed to appear in court after being previously charged with Possession of Methamphetamine, Drug Paraphernalia-Possession, and Possession of Marijuana. She was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
2. On Monday, September 19, 2022, around 8pm, Sheriff Brent White was dispatched to a two-vehicle injury collision at the intersection of KY 93 South and KY 293. The investigation revealed a 2011 Dodge 2500 pickup truck, driven by Johnnie Neal (79) of Livingston, Texas, was stopped at the stop sign on KY 293 at the KY 93 South intersection, when the driver attempted to turn left and pulled into the path of a North bound 2009 Toyota Corolla driven by Clinton Long (36). Long was injured, slightly but declined medical attention. The Eddyville Police Department assisted Lyon County Sheriff's Office at the scene.
3. On Monday, September 19, 2022, around 8:30pm, Deputy Seth P'Pool responded to a single vehicle collision in Kuttawa at the intersection of Old Kuttawa Road and Lakeshore Drive. The investigation revealed a 2019 Ford Fusion driven by Kevin Trovillion (60) of Clarksville, TN, ran off the roadway and impacted a rock embankment before nearly entering a pond. Trovillion was picked up by a passer-by but was quickly located by Deputy P'Pool near Exit 40. Trovillion was arrested and charged with DUI-1<sup>st</sup> Offense. He was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
