



LYONS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

1. On Saturday, October 1, 2022, around 12:20pm, Chief Deputy Sam Adams and Deputy David Carroll were dispatched to a single vehicle collision on KY 818 North. This was a delayed report, whereby the operator was transported from the scene by a third party to a local hospital. The investigation revealed a 2019 Ford Edge, driven by Kay Wheeler (78) of Eddyville was North on KY 818 when her wheels dropped off the pavement and the driver over-corrected before losing control and colliding with two trees. Ms. Wheeler sustained minor injuries in the collision.
2. On Monday, October 3, 2022, around 9:50am, CSO Deputy Dennis Beckett served a Calloway County Arrest Warrant on David E. Marutzky (39) of Paducah for Promoting Contraband-2nd Degree. Marutzky was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
3. On Wednesday, October 5, 2022, around 10:55pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon was dispatched to Days Inn Drive in Kuttawa for a disturbance. Following an investigation, Deputy Witherspoon arrested Jorge A. Martinez (33) of Chesterfield, MO, charging him with Alcohol Intoxication in a Public Place-1st or 2nd Offense. Martinez was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
4. On Friday, October 7, 2022, around 8:13am, Chief Deputy Sam Adams served indictment warrants on the following offenders:
 - a. Timothy W. May (44) of Kuttawa – Possession of Meth-2nd Offense and Drug Paraphernalia Possession.
 - b. Alan M. Pettus (40) of Madisonville – Resisting Arrest, Trafficking Meth-greater than 2 grams, Drug Paraphernalia Possession, Possession of a Handgun by a Convicted Felon, Assault-3rd Degree, and Persistent Felony Offender-I.
 - c. Scott Clayton (64) of Kuttawa – Possession of Meth-2nd Offense and Drug Paraphernalia Possession.

5. On Monday, October 10, 2022, Sheriff Brent White was dispatched to a two-vehicle collision on US 62 West in Kuttawa at the intersection of I-24. The investigation revealed a 2017 Chevrolet Traverse driven by Judy A. Blackwell (76) of Owensville, MO failed to stop at the stop sign at the end of the exit ramp and pulled into the path of a truck/trailer driven by Bradley Griffith (29) of Kevil. Thankfully, there were no injuries in the collision.
6. On Monday, October 10, 2022, CSO Deputy Dennis Beckett served an Estill County Bench Warrant on Jennifer G. Pryor (39) of Irvine. She is charged with Contempt of Court for two offenses including a probation violation. She is lodged in the Ross-Cash Correctional Complex.
