



## **LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT**

1. On Wednesday, October 13, 2021, at 9:30am, Sheriff Brent White arrested Demsey Ramos Cruz (37) of Monticello after he attempted to enter the Judicial Building and was found to be wanted by Court Security Deputies on a Failure to Appear warrant.
2. On Wednesday, October 13, 2021, around 11:20am, Deputy Keith Suits took a stolen firearm report from the Dryden Creek area. The victim reported a .22 caliber rifle taken some time between June and August of this year from his home in the South end of the county. The investigation is continuing and if anyone has information about this crime, they are asked to contact Deputy Suits at (270) 388-2311.
3. On Thursday, October 14, 2021, around 1:10pm, School Resource Deputy Chris Smith charged a 15-year-old student with Possession of Marijuana and Drug Paraphernalia after finding the juvenile in possession of the contraband while at school. The child was cited to court and released from school to a parent.
4. On Friday, October 15, 2021, around 4pm, Sheriff Brent White recovered some stolen property taken in a series of burglaries and thefts in the Suwanee area over the last four months. The investigation has resulted in felony charges against a juvenile and the arrest of an adult family member on numerous warrants out of Calloway County. The adult's involvement in the crimes remains under investigation and additional charges may be pending in Lyon County for these offenses.
5. An investigation led by Deputy Sam Adams, with assistance from Deputies Joe Witherspoon and Seth P'Pool, continues into the death of Virginia Bozarth of Kuttawa. An autopsy was performed last week in Madisonville and the preliminary findings indicate Ms. Bozarth's death was attributed to elder abuse/neglect issues. A preliminary hearing was held on Friday, October 15,

2021, at 9am, in Lyon District Court, for William D. Hammonds (50) of Kuttawa, who is charged with Wanton Abuse/Neglect of an Adult as it pertains to Ms. Bozarth's condition prior to her death. Hammonds was the only caretaker for Bozarth at the time of this incident. He remains lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center under a \$100,000.00 cash bond, which was increased from the original \$50,000.00 after his arrest. Following the hearing on Friday, Hammonds' case was bound over to the Lyon County Grand Jury, where they could hear a request for a more serious charge(s) relating to one of Kentucky's criminal homicide statutes. 6. On Monday, October 18, 2021, Sheriff Brent White charged Jason A. McGregor (28) of Princeton, with Fleeing/Evading Police-2<sup>nd</sup> Degree (motor vehicle). This charge was related to a pursuit from September 28, 2021, when McGregor was driving a vehicle reported stolen in Princeton and in which he led law enforcement on a multi-county pursuit for over 30 miles, before it was called off for safety reasons. McGregor was a wanted fugitive at the time of the initial pursuit, and he is currently lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center following another pursuit on or about October 9, 2021.
