



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On Thursday, September 30, 2021, around 1:55pm, Sheriff Brent White was dispatched to a single-vehicle, rollover, injury collision on KY 93 North approximately ½ mile North of Kuttawa. The investigation revealed a 2001 Mazda pickup truck, driven by Ramiro Hernandez, Jr. (18) of Kuttawa was North bound on KY 93 when he failed to negotiate a curve and left the roadway before going airborne and overturning. Hernandez was injured in the collision but declined EMS at the scene.
2. On Sunday, October 3, 2021, around 6am, Sheriff White was dispatched to a single-vehicle, rollover injury collision on KY 274, approximately 8 miles South of Eddyville. The investigation revealed a 2018 Chevrolet Cruze, driven by Tiffany Barbre (33) of Cadiz was South bound on KY 274 when she failed to negotiate a curve and left the roadway before impacting trees and overturning down a 35 feet embankment. The vehicle came to rest on its top and the operator was trapped before being freed by the Eddyville Fire Department and Lyon County EMS personnel. She was transported to Lourdes/Mercy Hospital in Paducah for treatment of her injuries.

Sheriff White credited OnStar's Automatic Crash Response system with helping first responders locate Barbre and her severely damaged vehicle.

"We don't usually give commercial shout-outs, but if it had not been for OnStar, first responders would not have located this vehicle for a considerable amount of time due to its final rest position, which was down a steep embankment and under the canopy of thick vegetation. The victim was upside down, injured, and trapped without any means of communication. Her vehicle was not visible from the roadway. Rescue crews had driven by the victim many times until being directed to the exact, pinpointed location with the help of the OnStar advisor and the Kentucky State Police dispatcher who worked together," said Sheriff White.
