



## LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On Saturday, November 6, 2021, around 7:23am, Deputy Sam Adams investigated a single-vehicle collision on Parkersville Road, approximately 10 miles South of Eddyville. A 2019 Hyundai, driven by Sharon Lynch (67) of Eddyville was South bound when a deer entered her lane of travel. Lynch was unable to avoid the collision and struck the deer. No injuries were reported; however, the vehicle did sustain damage.
2. On Sunday, November 7, 2021, around 8:08pm, Deputy Seth P'Pool investigated a single-vehicle collision on I-69, approximately 5 miles Southeast of Eddyville. A 2021 Freightliner semi, driven by Sonya Pryor (53) of Goose Creek, SC was North bound when she struck at deer at the scene of another, unrelated deer collision being investigated by deputies. Pryor was not injured; however, the vehicle did sustain damage.
3. On Monday, November 8, 2021, around 1:10pm, Deputy Seth P'Pool arrested Joseph Knight (41) of Beechmont in Kuttawa. Knight was a fugitive from Lyon Circuit Court and Caldwell Circuit Court where he failed to appear in several theft related cases. He was served with bench warrants for both counties. Knight was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
4. On Wednesday, November 10, 2021, at 9:30am, Sheriff Brent White served a parole violation warrant on Jeffrey A. Williams (32) of Eddyville. Williams was wanted from the state of Georgia for violating his parole in Kentucky. Williams was lodged in the Caldwell County Detention Center.
5. On Wednesday, November 10, 2021, at 10:10am, Deputy Adams and Sheriff White responded to a theft complaint in the Suwanee community. The victim reported a considerable amount of furniture and other household items were stolen from a rental unit. The investigation is continuing, and no arrests have been made at this time; however, suspects have been identified.

6. On Wednesday, November 10, 2021, at 1:40pm, Sheriff White responded to a theft complaint on KY 810 North. The victim reported numerous tools and some jewelry stolen from her residence. The investigation is continuing, and no arrests have been made at this time; however, a suspect has been identified.
7. On Thursday, November 11, 2021, at 8:30am, Deputy Chris Smith charged a 13-year-old juvenile with Terroristic Threatening-3<sup>rd</sup> Degree following an investigation of a threat whereby the juvenile encouraged another student to end their life and told the juvenile if they didn't do so, they would kill the victim themselves. The threat was witnessed by a school staff member who alerted the School Resource Officer. Following an investigation, the juvenile was detained, charged, and released to the custody of a parent pending a court appearance.
8. On Friday, November 12, 2021, around 1:40am, Deputy Keith Suits conducted a traffic stop on US 62 East of Eddyville. The driver was identified as Ryan E. Renner (28) of Marion. He was charged with Speeding, Operating on a Suspended/Revoked License, Possession of Open Alcohol Container in Motor Vehicle, Drug Paraphernalia Possession, and Possession of Controlled Substance-1<sup>st</sup> Degree (Methamphetamine).

In addition, Renner was found to be a fugitive, as he was wanted out of McCracken County for Bail Jumping-1<sup>st</sup> Degree and Contempt of Court. Deputy Suits served both warrants on Renner. He was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

A passenger in Renner's vehicle, identified as Kursten A. Myers (24) of Henderson was charged with Illegal Possession of a Legend Drug, Possession of Marijuana, and Drug Paraphernalia Possession. She was cited to Lyon District Court and released.
