



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

- 1.** On Sunday, November 13, 2022, around 4:30pm, Sheriff Brent White answered a medical assistance call on Mayhugh Road in the Southern portion of the county. After assisting Lyon EMS, he observed Brett M. Whitney (33) of Eddyville on the property. Whitney was the subject of a social media post the Sheriff's Office had recently put out regarding trespassing incidents in the Lamasco area. Whitney was charged with Criminal Trespassing-2nd Degree and cited to Lyon District Court.
- 2.** On Monday, November 14, 2022, around 5:15pm, Deputy David Carroll was dispatched to a single vehicle collision on I-24. The investigation revealed a 2020 Toyota Highlander was East on I-24 around the 46-mile marker when it collided with a deer in the roadway. The driver, Edward Turbeville (61) of Nashville, Tennessee was seat belted and not injured in the collision.
- 3.** On Monday, November 14, 2022, around 7:45pm, Deputy David Carroll was dispatched to a single vehicle collision on I-24. The investigation revealed a 2020 Mercedes Benz was West on I-24 around the 50-mile marker when it collided with a deer in the roadway. The driver, Sheila Wulff (66) of Naples, Florida was seat belted and not injured in the collision.
- 4.** On Tuesday, November 15, 2022, around 9:50am, Sheriff Brent White was dispatched to a two-vehicle collision in Kuttawa at the Huck's Travel Center. The investigation revealed a 2017 Chevrolet Silverado driven by Milo Hachtel (63) of Herndon backed into a 2012 Chrysler 200 owned by Daniel Harris (61) of Eddyville. No injuries were reported.

5. On Tuesday, November 15, 2022, around 11:30am, Deputy Lori Francis charged Joseph L. Owen (37) of Fredonia with a McCracken District Court bench warrant for Criminal Mischief-1st Degree. He will remain at the Western Kentucky Correctional Complex until being transferred to McCracken County.

6. On Wednesday, November 16, 2022, around 11am, Sheriff White received the fifteen (15th) sixteenth (16th) report of vandalism to mailboxes. The incidents have occurred on the following roadways: KY 93S, KY 293, KY 730E, KY 3305, US 641N, and Rube Adams Road. 7. On Thursday, November 17, 2022, around 8:45pm, Deputy Jeremy Hillyard assisted Kentucky State Police and other first responder agencies with a single vehicle injury collision on KY 293 which resulted in a fatality. The collision remains under investigation by Kentucky State Police.

8. On Friday, November 18, 2022, around 8:45am, Chief Deputy Sam Adams charged Trinidad Wilford (54) of Eddyville with Theft by Deception. Wilford is accused of drawing upon a cold check to satisfy a bill at Williams Vet Clinic. She was summoned to Lyon District Court regarding the matter.

9. On Friday, November 18, 2022, around 11:30am, Chief Deputy Sam Adams answered an identity theft complaint. The investigation revealed a Lyon County citizen reported someone used his bank credit card and personal information to purchase an electronic device. The item was shipped to a Florida address. The investigation is continuing.

10. On Saturday, November 19, 2022, around 1:35am, Deputy David Carroll and Kuttawa Fire Department responded to a house fire in the 3000 block of KY 295 North. Upon arrival of Deputy Carroll, he could not get anyone to respond and there was a car in the driveway of the home. He kicked in the front door of the residence and searched for anybody in the home. Before he could finish searching the home, he was forced to exit after the flames pushed him out. The family members were later located at another residence unharmed. Despite the efforts of fire fighters, the home was a total loss.
