



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

1. On Sunday, November 14, 2021, around 6:45pm, Deputy Keith Suits made a traffic stop on US 62 West in Kuttawa for numerous traffic violations. The operator, Joseph David Daricek (31) of Twin Lake, MI was charged with several traffic violations and the vehicle was impounded. Further investigation resulted in a search warrant being executed on the vehicle and on Wednesday, November 17, 2021, Daricek was charged with Possession of Controlled Substance-1st Degree, 1st Offense (Methamphetamine).
2. On Tuesday, November 16, 2021, around 9:45pm, Deputy Seth P'Pool and Eddyville Police responded to a disturbance on KY 1055 near Old Eddyville. A vehicle was stopped when it was observed leaving the area where the 911 call was received from. A passenger in the vehicle, Garen G. Oliver (21) of Nortonville was charged with Possession of Marijuana and Drug Paraphernalia. He was cited to Court for this offense.

Further investigation into the original disturbance resulted in the arrest of Brian W. Rodriguez (26) of Eddyville. He was charged with Assault-4th Degree, Possession of Marijuana, and Drug Paraphernalia. In addition, Amanda N. Cranick (22) of Eddyville was also arrested by Deputy P'Pool and charged with Assault-4th Degree. Both subjects were lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

3. On Wednesday, November 17, 2021, around 5pm, Deputy Seth P'Pool was dispatched to a single vehicle collision on US 62 near KY 295 North. The investigation revealed a 2019 Nissan Murano being operated by Whitney Oliver (33) of Kuttawa was West bound when deer entered her lane of travel resulting in a collision. There were no injuries reported; however, the vehicle sustained significant damage.

4. On Saturday, November 20, 2021, around 9:48pm, Deputy Keith Suits conducted a traffic stop on a 2016 Dodge Charger on US 62 East for a speeding violation. Further investigation resulted in the driver, William D. Miller (20) of Paducah being charged with Possession of Marijuana in addition to the traffic charges. He was cited to court for all of these offenses.

5. On Monday, November 22, 2021, around 2pm, Deputy Keith Suits and KSP Trooper Nathan Clinkenbeard responded to Eddy Creek Road due to a bond violation complaint. Once on scene, they made contact with Kevin R. Mosier (59) of Eddyville. Mosier was arrested on a Bench Warrant from Lyon Circuit Court whereby he reportedly left a drug rehabilitation facility without successfully completing the program and without returning to jail upon being discharged. In addition, he was forbidden by the Circuit Court's order from being at the property he was found at the time of his arrest. Mosier was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
