



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On Monday, November 1, 2021, just around 12:15pm, Sheriff Brent White arrested Andrew M. Freeman (34) of Clarksville, TN, while in Eddyville, on a bench warrant from Christian District Court for Failure to Appear. Freeman was able to later post bond and was released from custody.
2. On Monday, November 1, 2021, around 12:35pm, Sheriff Brent White arrested Joseph R. Ward (39) of West Paducah, while in Eddyville, on a bench warrant from Lyon District Court for Failure to Appear. He was turned over to the custody of the Jailer in Lyon District Court, which was in session at the time of his arrest.
3. On Wednesday, November 3, 2021, around 10:45am, Deputy Sam Adams and Sheriff White arrested Brendan E. Durham (20) of Eddyville following an early morning investigation. Deputies were called to the Caldwell County Medical Center for a victim who was being treated in the Emergency Room. The investigation revealed the victim was assaulted at a residence in Southern Lyon County and was transported to the ER for treatment of injuries sustained in the altercation. Deputy Adams charged Durham with Assault-4th Degree. Durham was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
4. On Thursday, November 4, 2021, around 1:05pm, Deputy Sam Adams and Sheriff White were assisting KY Probation & Parole Officers in the Lamasco community when they came into contact with Tara Escobar (43) and Gerald G. Cotton (64) both of Eddyville on Mayhugh Road. Following an investigation, Escobar was arrested by Deputy Adams and charged with Operating on a Suspended/Revoked License, Failure to Wear Seat Belt, No Insurance, Possession of Marijuana, and Illegal Possession of a Legend Drug. Cotton was arrested by Sheriff White and charged with Possession of Marijuana and Drug Paraphernalia Possession. At the time of this offense, Cotton was on state probation for Marijuana and Methamphetamine related convictions. Both subjects were lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

5. On Thursday, November 4, 2021, around 8:45pm, Deputy Keith Suits was dispatched to Vista Drive in Kuttawa for a semi-truck which had gotten stuck in a ditch off the city street. Upon assisting the driver, Deputy Suits smelled Marijuana emitting from the cab of the semi-truck. An investigation revealed the driver, identified as Pedro Luis Acevedo, Jr. (39) of Clute, Texas possessed Marijuana in the vehicle. He was charged with Possession of Marijuana and cited to Lyon District Court.
6. On Saturday, November 6, 2021, just after 4pm, Deputy Keith Suits charged Jordan S. Baize (37) of Kuttawa on an Indictment Warrant out of Lyon Circuit Court with Theft by Deception Over \$1,000. Baize is lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
7. On Sunday, November 7, 2021, just before 8pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon was dispatched to a single vehicle collision on I-69 near the 70 mile post. The investigation revealed a 2013 Nissan Altima, driven by Autumn Rodgers (20) of Boaz was North bound when a deer entered her lane causing a collision. The airbags deployed on the vehicle and the driver was restrained in a seat belt; thus, escaping injury in the collision.
