Reference: Disturbance complaint leads to arrest of wanted fugitive

KY 295 – Kuttawa

At 4:48 pm on December 26, 2019, the Lyon County Sheriff's Office responded to a disturbance complaint in the 600 block of KY 295. The caller reported a vehicle not known to them had pulled into a driveway and several subjects appeared to be outside arguing.

Deputy Seth P'Pool responded and detained three people involved in the dispute. Further investigation identified a passenger in the vehicle as Travis L. Whitehair (22) of Paducah. Whitehair was a fugitive from Perry County, IL; Massac County, IL; Calloway County, KY; Crittenden County, KY; and Lyon County, KY. In addition, he had an active Parole Violation Warrant for his arrest. All of the KY warrants were for theft related offenses. Whitehair was arrested and transported to the Lyon County Jailer, who then lodged this fugitive in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

The remaining subjects in the vehicle were released with no charges at this time. The Lyon County Sheriff's Office was assisted by the Eddyville Police Department. A digital photograph of the offender is attached as a matter of reference.
