



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

1. On Wednesday, April 20, 2022, at 3:30pm, Chief Deputy Sam Adams charged Joseph Gillaspie (41) of Kuttawa with a Failure to Appear Bench Warrant from Lyon District Court. Gillaspie remains lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
2. On Thursday, April 21, 2022, at 10:30am, Chief Deputy Sam Adams investigated a single vehicle collision on US 641 North, approximately 1 mile North of Eddyville. His investigation revealed a 2015 Volvo semi-truck and trailer was Northbound when the driver failed to negotiate a curve after dropping a wheel off the right shoulder. The truck and trailer crossed both lanes of travel before impacting an embankment and utility phone box and pole. After the initial collision, the truck and trailer crossed both lanes of travel again before impacting a second ditch and coming to rest blocking the roadway.

The driver, identified as, Steven H. Azzo (31) of Sterling Heights, MI was not injured; however, he received several commercial vehicle safety citations from a Kentucky State Police (KSP) Commercial Vehicle Enforcement (CVE) Officer. US 641 North was shut down for a few hours, while the wrecker company removed the vehicle.

Chief Deputy Adams was assisted by Lyon County EMS, Eddyville Fire Department, the KSP CVE Division, and the KY Department of Highways.
