



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On May 5, 2021 around 7:20am, Deputy Sam Adams and Sheriff Brent White responded to a complaint from Pennyrile Central Dispatch of a shoplifter, believed to be coming into Lyon County, from Wal-Mart in Princeton who fled the scene after trying to be stopped by store personnel. The description of the vehicle was given as well as a registration plate number. The vehicle was reportedly last seen traveling West bound on US 62 out of Princeton.

Deputy Adams and Sheriff White responded to US 62 East and located the suspect vehicle; a 2012, Dodge pickup truck, red in color with the matching registration plate number provided by the caller. A traffic stop was conducted on US 62 near Park Avenue in Eddyville.

The vehicle was operated by Brandon T. Allen (33) of Marion, formerly of Louisville. He was found to be in possession of suspected Methamphetamine and suspected Marijuana which was observed in plain view on the dash of the truck. He was arrested and searched. During the search, merchandise stolen from Wal-Mart was located in his possession. In addition, Methamphetamine, Marijuana, and drug paraphernalia was also seized from Allen's possession.

The Princeton Police Department responded and charged Allen with Theft by Unlawful Taking Under \$500. Deputy Adams charged Allen with the following offenses:

1. Possession of Controlled Substance-1st Degree (Methamphetamine)
 2. Possession of Marijuana
 3. Drug Paraphernalia-Buy/Possess
 4. Operating on a Suspended/Revoked Operator's License
 5. Failure to Produce an Insurance Card
2. On May 7, 2021 around noon, Sheriff Brent White was assisting the Department for Community Based Services with a child welfare check at a residence off KY 818 North when he located Savannah M. Wittmer (29) of Grand Rivers. Wittmer was determined to be a wanted fugitive from Daviess

County. Wittmer was arrested and charged with an indictment warrant for Escape in the 2nd Degree. She was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
