



## LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On Friday, September 3, 2021, around 2pm, Deputy Sam Adams was dispatched to Silver Trail in the Land Between the Lakes National Recreation Area to investigate a single vehicle collision. The investigation revealed a 2002 Honda motorcycle being operated by Gary Hix (71) of Cadiz was East bound on Silver Trail when he failed to negotiate a curve after encountering some loose gravel on the roadway. Hix was transported to an area hospital by Trigg County EMS for non-life-threatening injuries.
2. On Tuesday, September 7, 2021, around 1:25pm, Deputy Adams served an indictment warrant on Mary Johnson (39) of Harlan for Possession of Methamphetamine, Drug Paraphernalia, and No Operator's License.
3. On Thursday, September 9, 2021, around 11:30am, Sheriff Brent White and Deputy Sam Adams made contact with two subjects in a 2002 Chevrolet Trailblazer in the Suwanee community off US 62 West. After further investigation and the search of the vehicle, a handgun was recovered from under the front seat of the truck, as well as drug paraphernalia. The driver was identified as Justin S. Bell (43) of Dawson Springs, and the passenger was identified as Lawrence S. Lozano, Jr. (47) of Gilbertsville. Lozano was out of custody on bond for drug related offenses in Caldwell and Marshall Counties. The investigation revealed both subjects were convicted felons and unable to legally possess a firearm. Both subjects were detained and charged as follows:

Bell:

Improper Registration Plate  
Failure to Produce Insurance Card  
Drug Paraphernalia – Buy/Possess  
Possession of Handgun by Convicted Felon

Lozano:

Possession of Open Alcoholic Beverage Container in Motor Vehicle  
Failure to Surrender Revoked Operator's License  
Drug Paraphernalia – Buy/Possess  
Possession of Handgun by Convicted Felon

4. On Friday, September 10, 2021, at 10am, Deputy Sam Adams served a Lyon Circuit Court Probation Violation Warrant for a Felony Offense on Logan W. Daugherty (25) of Blue Springs, Missouri, following his extradition from Kansas City back to Kentucky. His original charges including multiple drug offenses. He remains lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
5. On Saturday, September 11, 2021, just after midnight, Deputy Keith Suits arrested Brooke V. Strickland (22) following a reckless driving complaint and traffic stop on US 62 West. She was found to be an impaired driver and was charged with DUI 1<sup>st</sup> Offense. She was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
6. On Saturday, September 11, 2021, around 7:15am, Deputy Sam Adams was dispatched to a theft complaint at Buzzard Rock Marina. The investigation revealed the owner of the marina reported a 26 ft. teal colored pontoon boat was stolen from the dock in the early morning hours. Deputy Adams later located the stolen boat at Kuttawa Harbor Marina where he arrested William M. McQuigg, Jr. (39) of Kuttawa. The stolen boat was recovered and was valued at \$18,000.00. McQuigg was charged with Theft by Unlawful Taking \$10,000 but under \$1,000,000 in value. He was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center. At the time of this offense, McQuigg was on Parole for previous felony convictions.
7. On Saturday, September 11, 2021, around 4:40pm, Deputy Keith Suits conducted a traffic stop of a 2016 Dodge Charger, on KY 810 South. During the roadside investigation, the driver was identified as Jacob H. Armstrong (37) of Kuttawa. Armstrong had previously failed to appear in court numerous times for other traffic offenses. His license was found to have a suspended operator's license and he could not produce valid proof of insurance. Deputy Suits arrested Armstrong and charged him with No Insurance-2<sup>nd</sup> Offense and Operating on a Suspended/Revoked License. He was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
