



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On February 17, 2021 around 8:30am, Deputy Sam Adams charged Roy N. Gross of Winchester on a Clark County warrant for Failure to Appear in Court.
2. On February 17, 2021 around 10:00am, Deputy Sam Adams charged William M. Higgins (40) of Benton with Violation of a KY EPO/DVO. The charges stem from an investigation which started on February 6, 2021.
3. On February 19, 2021 around 1:02pm, Sheriff Brent White charged Phoenix C. Dunn (23) of Smyrna, TN on a Lyon Circuit Court Indictment Warrant for Resisting Arrest, Fleeing/Evading Police (on foot)-2nd Degree, Criminal Mischief-3rd Degree, and Receiving Stolen Property-Under \$10,000. Dunn was extradited from Robertson County, TN.
4. On February 19, 2021 around 11:05pm while on patrol, Deputy Keith Suits made a traffic stop on KY 810 South. Jacob R. Cartwright (19) of Kuttawa was operating a 2012 Nissan Altima and found to be under the influence of alcohol and drugs. He was given field sobriety tests and found to possess suspected marijuana and drug paraphernalia. He was arrested by Deputy Suits and charged with DUI-1st Offense, Possession of Open Alcoholic Beverage Container in a Motor Vehicle, Possession of Marijuana, Drug Paraphernalia Possession, and Operating a Vehicle with an Expired Operator's License.
5. On February 21, 2021 around 12:50am, Deputies Seth P'Pool and Keith Suits were called to the Super 8 Motel in Eddyville due to a domestic dispute complaint. Upon their arrival, they met with a female victim who appeared to have been assaulted. The investigation revealed Raphael L. Hastie (48) of Evansville, IN was intoxicated when he physically assaulted the female at the motel. In addition, while the victim was attempting to call 911 for help, the offender allegedly broke her cellular phone.

While Sheriff's Deputies were investigating this incident, Hastie threatened them multiple times. Hastie told deputies he had a history of killing and desired to kill them also. Hastie was arrested and charged with Assault-4th Degree (domestic

violence), Terroristic Threatening-3rd Degree, Interfering with Communications, and Menacing.

This is the second time in the past two months, this offender has been arrested for the same offense at an area motel. Hastie entered a guilty plea to Assault-4th Degree on January 20, 2021 following an incident in Kuttawa.

6. On February 21, 2021 around 10:34am, Deputy Seth P'Pool was dispatched to Moon Bay Drive in Kuttawa for a reported burglary. The investigation revealed a storage building at this location had been entered and numerous hand tools and power tools were taken. 7. On February 21, 2021 around 9:00pm, Deputy Witherspoon was dispatched to a 2-vehicle, injury collision in Kuttawa at the intersection of Lakeshore Drive and US 62 West. The investigation revealed a 2008 Suzuki SUV operated by Scott Clayton (62) of Kuttawa was turning from Lakeshore Drive onto US 62 Westbound when he pulled into the path of a 1999 Dodge Ram pickup truck operated by Stacie Enochs (28) of Kuttawa. The collision caused the Clayton vehicle to overturn on its side. A passenger in the Enoch's vehicle, Alex Enochs (30) of Kuttawa, was transported by Lyon County EMS, to Lourdes Hospital in Paducah for injuries he sustained in the collision.
