



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

On Sunday, August 8, 2021, around 8:40pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon was on patrol in Kuttawa when he made a traffic stop on a 2003 Chevrolet Tracker for the operator disregarding a stop sign. During a roadside investigation, he determined the operator, Charles N. Collins (43) of Hermitage, TN, was operating on a driver's license previously suspended for a DUI and he was under the influence of alcoholic beverages.

Deputy Witherspoon arrested Collins and charged him with the following offenses:

1. Disregarding a Stop Sign
2. Driving on a DUI Suspended License-1st Offense
3. DUI – 2nd Offense (alcohol)
4. No Registration
5. Improper Display of Registration Plates

Collins was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
