



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On Friday, May 14, 2021 around 10:42am, Deputy Sam Adams responded to a two-vehicle collision on KY 293, 4 miles South of Eddyville. The investigation revealed a 2015 Nissan Murano driven by Frank Sollman (81) of Gilbertsville was exiting the Eastbound off-ramp to I-24 when he failed to stop at the stop sign at the end of the ramp. Sollman's vehicle collided with a 2013 Honda Civic driven by Taylor Carney (21) of Eddyville, who was West bound on KY 293. There were no injuries reported in this collision.
2. On Saturday, May 15, 2021 around 6:55pm, Deputy Keith Suits served a Lyon County Circuit Court bench warrant on Darius D. Harris (23) of Owensboro for Contempt of Court pursuant to a bond violation. Harris is charged in a 2020 Lyon Circuit Court Indictment for Trafficking Marijuana Greater than 5 lbs., Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument-1st Degree, and Speeding. He was listed as a fugitive since April and was found in Indiana before being extradited back to Kentucky.
3. On Saturday, May 15, 2021 around 11:40pm, Deputy Keith Suits conducted a traffic stop on a 1998 Chevrolet pickup truck on US 641, approximately 3 miles North of Eddyville. The vehicle was driven by Alexander B. Gamblin (20) of Marion, formerly of Paducah. He was found to be operating on an expired operator's license and he had not notified the Transportation Cabinet of his change of address. In addition, he was found to be in possession of marijuana. He was cited to court on these three offenses.
4. On Sunday, May 16, 2021 around 6:55pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon responded to a single vehicle collision on KY 810 South, approximately 4 miles Southwest of Kuttawa. The investigation revealed a 2003 Chevrolet Monte Carlo driven by Carlyn L. Claibourn (73) of Kuttawa was South on KY 810 when a deer entered the roadway in her path. The driver attempted to avoid the animal and in doing so, lost control of the vehicle. The vehicle left the roadway before entering a creek where the driver was trapped for a short period of time. The driver refused medical attention at the scene. The

Kuttawa Fire Department and Lyon County EMS assisted Deputy Witherspoon at the scene.

5. On Sunday, May 16, 2021 around 11:35pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon was dispatched to a commercial vehicle collision on Interstate 24, Eastbound, at the 46-mile marker. The investigation revealed a 2016 Western Star 5800 Series truck was Eastbound when a tire on the tractor truck failed, causing the truck's driver to lose control and exit the right side of the highway in a marked construction zone. No construction workers were present at the time of the collision. During the collision, the trailer broke loose from the semi and rolled over on its side. The driver was transported to the Caldwell County Medical Center by Lyon County EMS for his injuries. In addition to Lyon County EMS, the Eddyville Fire Department assisted Deputy Witherspoon at the scene.

6. On Monday, May 17, 2021 around 8:10am, Sheriff Brent White took a theft report from a Marion man who stated he was parked at Lee S. Jones Park on Saturday, May 15, 2021 between the hours of 9:30am and noon. He left a cold compression therapy machine in the bed of his parked pickup truck and when he returned, he reported the item had been stolen.
