



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On Wednesday, May 19, 2021 around 7:35pm, Deputy Joe Witherspoon responded to a single vehicle collision on Interstate 24 near the 35-mile marker. The investigation revealed Ken Coash (64) of Rantoul, Illinois was driving a 2018 Toyota Highlander East bound on I-24 when a tire failed on a 2013 Volvo commercial vehicle driven by Greg M. Yeffeth of Florida. The tire debris collided with the Toyota vehicle causing damage to it. There were no injuries reported in this incident.
2. On Wednesday, May 19, 2021 around 8:15pm, Deputy Keith Suits conducted a traffic stop on a 2013 Nissan Altima on US 62 West for not having illuminated headlamps. The driver was identified as Faith N. Gossum (21) of Princeton. She was found to be driving on a suspended operator's license. She was charged with Operating on a Suspended/Revoked Operator's License, Display/Possession of a Cancelled or Fictitious License, and Failure of Owner to Maintain Required Liability Insurance-1st Offense.

On Friday, May 21, 2021 around 8pm, Lyon County Sheriff's Deputies were assisting Kentucky State Police troopers with a checkpoint near the Lyon/Livingston County line near the entrance to the LBL National Recreation Area. Deputy Seth P'Pool made contact with the driver of a 1998 Dodge Durango driven by Robert P. Greer (23) of Hampton. Greer was arrested by Deputy P'Pool after it was discovered he was driving on license previously suspended for a DUI. Greer was charged with Driving on a DUI Suspended License-1st Offense, Improper Registration Plate, and Failure of Owner to Maintain Required Insurance-1st Offense.
