



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACTIVITY REPORT

1. On Tuesday, May 25, 2021 around 10am, Sheriff Brent White was following up on an unrelated investigation when he discovered Gary W. Wagoner (60) of Kuttawa had a Failure to Appear warrant for his arrest out of Madison County, Illinois. Wagoner was arrested and charged with being a Fugitive from Justice. He was turned over to the Lyon County Jailer.
2. On Wednesday, May 26, 2021 at 11:10am, Deputy Sam Adams located and arrested Michael J. Burns (34) of Eddyville on 3rd Street in Old Eddyville. Burns was charged on a Bond Violation warrant out of Lyon Circuit Court where he is under indictment for multiple offenses stemming from a 2020 incident. Burns was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
3. On Wednesday, May 26, 2021 after noon, officers with the Lyon County Sheriff's Office and Eddyville Police Department conducted a highway safety detail in conjunction with the Click It or Ticket campaign on US 62 West. During the detail officers issued five (5) total citations and arrested one driver for operating on a suspended/revoked license due to his failure to answer a court summons.
4. On Wednesday, May 26, 2021 at 3:37pm, Deputy Sam Adams and Deputy Joe Witherspoon responded to a 3-vehicle injury collision at the intersection of I-24 and US 62 West. The investigation by Deputy Adams revealed a 2016 Freightliner driven by Magnus Nwakuna (51) of Colorado Springs, CO exited the West bound off-ramp. Nwakuna failed to yield the right of way to a 2012 Peterbilt driven by George Johnson (62) of Madisonville. The Johnson semi-truck sideswiped the 2016 Freightliner before colliding with a 1999 Jeep Cherokee driven by Donald 'Donnie' Lewis (52) of Eddyville. Lewis was injured in the collision and transported by Lyon County EMS to Lourdes Hospital. All three vehicles sustained significant damage in this collision.

The Lyon County Sheriff's Office was assisted by Kuttawa Fire Department, Lyon County Emergency Management, Eddyville Police Department, and KYTC personnel.

5. On Thursday, May 27, 2021 around 3:30pm Deputy Sam Adams was dispatched to a disturbance complaint in Eddyville. He located the Zachery J. Brown (25) of Marion at the Fivestar Convenience Store in Eddyville. Brown was operating a 2012 Dodge Avenger. Further investigation by Deputy Adams determined Brown did not have a valid driver's license. He was charged with No Operator's License. There were no charges filed stemming from the alleged disturbance incident.

6. On Friday, May 28, 2021 around 12:55pm Deputy Sam Adams conducted a traffic stop on a 1998 Honda off West Main Street in Eddyville. The driver was identified as Ryan Allbright (61) of Kuttawa. He operator's license was determined to be suspended out of Indiana. He was charged with Operating on a Suspended/Revoked Operator's License.
